Gestalt & Line

Deliverable:

Cut Paper Collage on 14" x 17" Paper.

You will create a composition using only strips of paper (no wider than 1/2 inch) to create a drawing where each line is essential to the work. Your drawing can be static, or dynamic, symmetrical or asymmetrical, create pattern, value, harmony, etc, but must be based on a logical system of your making.

Requirements:

Create *Collage* incorporating the following:

- Cut lines of paper, no wider than 1/2 inch.
- A Compositional system of your making for a cut-paper drawing using only the Visual Element, *Line*.

What's the Point?

To learn about utilizing *Gestalt* in a work of art; to plan out and execute a *composition* that is cohesive and logical, where you will learn to make specific choices and be able to justify them. You will also learn to learn how to effectively use *Line* in a work of art.

What you will be graded on:

33.333% Completion of all above requirements (16.66% each).

33.333% Craftsmanship: Clean and straight paper cutting, and **no** erasure marks or glue residue.

33.333% An image taken for digital portfolio.
